

Buzzards' Peak is located southeast of Cameron, Texas. US 77/190 and State Route 36 run southeast from Cameron. Approximately 2.6 miles out of Cameron you will find FM 2095, just past the long bridge over the Little River. If you are coming from the South, you will find FM 2095 about 0.9 mile after US 77 intersects US 190/SR36.



Turn East onto FM 2095 and proceed approximately 1.5 miles, crossing the railroad tracks along the way. Look for a sign on your left for Aaron's Gun Shop. The sign is on the corner of FM 2095 and CR 228. Turn left onto CR 228.



Drive on CR 228 approximately 1.1 miles. As you near your next turn you will see two landmarks. The first will be a very large blue cactus on the left. Once you pass the cactus, look for a bright red barn on the right. The barn is located on CR 228C and you will drive in front of it as you go toward the TCC land site. The sign for CR 228C faces CR 228 and it is difficult to see it. Once you pass the cactus, slow down and be prepared to turn.

As you drive down CR 228C you will encounter a 90° degree turn to the right, then a 90° turn to the left. When you get to the entrance of the TCC land site you will see a For Sale sign for some other property in the area. Turn to the right to enter the land site. The composition of this road changes from gravel to clay and sand.
